





















































































































































































MOTIVATED MONSTER.

n late March 2025, we gathered "in the woods" near Viking Hills, Minnesota for our first VeeFriends comic team offsite.

The mission: get Gary Vaynerchuk's undivided attention for a few days to build the stories, lore, and world that would take VeeFriends to the next level.

Originally launched in May 2021, VeeFriends quickly became a successful collectible brand with major collaborations, from Macy's to Masters of the Universe. But Gary knew that for VeeFriends to grow into a monster IP, it needed to become a story brand. He wanted to be hands-on for the origin stories and world-building that would shape the future.

Working with Gary is rapid-fire. He doesn't like to waste time, and big ideas fly in like a machine gun. We had multiple note-takers, and, true to GaryVee style, cameras rolling to capture every story beat for the future.

Between deep work sessions, we bonded over food, wine, and conversations about life, family legacy, and the most random topics.

Gary has an insatiable curiosity. To the untrained eye, it might look like his mind is all over the place, but as a story-teller myself, I see he's gathering and collecting.

"Did you guys know that bees dream?" he said with a smirk. "Go on, look it up."

We did. Fascinating.

"Did ya know you can buy a house in Gary, Indiana for like a thousand bucks?" he joked, saying maybe he should move VeeFriends HQ there and put "Gary" back on the map.

I mentioned the Kensington Runestone, the artifact that suggests Vikings once roamed Minnesota, which is why the NFL team is called the Minnesota Vikings.

Day one alone, we laid out over 16 ensemble casts within our universe. The day was about big thinking—building out the character "teams" and exploring how the VeeFriends universe would work. It was fully collaborative, but Gary remained at the helm, steering us toward his vision for the characters.

I've studied comic book history for a long time, and I've never seen or felt anything like the creative energy Gary was cooking with. And I'm not just saying that because I work for the guy.:D Day two was all about individual character origins. Gary kept it collaborative, going around the room as we tossed out names and story seeds for the characters we wanted to develop. Some stuck, some didn't.

"Andy, who's the most underrated VeeFriend?" Gary asked.

Andy Krainak, President of VeeFriends, was wearing a purple Motivated Monster hat that day, and that was his pick.

Originally part of a Halloween set, Motivated Monster never had a backstory. Looking at him, you'd wonder: What's with the #5 on his cheek? Why the purple hat? How is he a monster?







"Motivated Monster is the champion of the positive outcast in a loser family," Gary began to riff. "He comes from a family of real losers. But his grandfather wasn't a loser..."

Over the next 30 minutes, Motivated Monster's core origin flowed from Gary as we bounced ideas back and forth. Pieces of conversations we'd had over the past days clicked into place, and a setting emerged: Gary, Indiana.

The family name started as "Loser-mens," but when Gary, talking fast, said "Larry Loserson," it stuck. "It means 'the son of losers'!" he laughed.

I couldn't stop thinking about those Vikings who may have roamed Minnesota's woods. The name "Lief Loserson" popped into my head like a whisper from the muse in the room.

Later, I asked, "What if Larry Loserson's ancestor was a Viking named Lief Loserson? And what if Lief was also the name of our Versatile Viking character, the first winner in the Loserson family line, connecting it all in canon?"

"Hmmm, could work... Let's play," Gary replied.

Play. That's exactly how I've described working with Gary from day one. It's like going to a friend's house as a kid, grabbing their toys, and making up adventures together. VeeFriends are Gary's toys, and together, we're building stories and a new universe.

Up until that moment in the Minnesota woods, no one had thought deeply about Motivated Monster's story, his motivations, or where he came from.

Now, we know: his story starts in Gary, Indiana.
And it's just the beginning.

TALES FROM THE DRAWING BOARD

"I wanted Motivated Monster to be grittier and darker than some of my previous work. I've never shied from heavy shadows, halftones, or lots of spot blacks, and I just wanted to add to that and layer more texture into these pages. Larry's world is heavy; shaped by trauma, betrayal, and survival - themes I wanted to be reflected in grainy inks and stratified halftones (but still clean and readable). My natural cartooniness peeks through, keeping things human, honest, and a little bit
